Amenities Committee May 2008

- Re Public Toilets in Newark The District Council has replied advising that they may promote a community toilet scheme whereby shops enter into a partnership agreement to make facilities available to visitors with appropriate signs in premises windows.
- Re Minute 1462 Car Park The bollards have been installed on the car park to the front of the reception doors.
- Re Minute 1470 Play Area Project The District Council has been advised of the preferred scheme, but the authority is unable to advise at this time regarding the schedule of installation. A further letter has been received from residents living adjacent to the play area disputing the measurements from their property.
- Re Minute 1471 Headstone safety Clarification has been sought from the Council's insurance company regarding liability issues.
- Re Minute 1472 Plan app. 2 Main St The application was scheduled for consideration at the District Council planning meeting on Tuesday June 24th 2008. Cllrs Mrs Hurst and Mrs Jarvis attended the meeting to speak against the application.
- Re Minute 1474 Broome Close The No Ball Games + No Parking sign has been installed on the green area at the junction of Broome Close and Blackthorne Close. One complaint has been received to date about the sign.
- Re Minute 1479e Centre window The Cricket Club has responded indicating a willingness to pay an amount of £83 + vat (from an alternative company's estimate). The Club is also seeking clarification for responsibility in the event of any further damage to property and vehicles from a match.
