Be part of Newark and Sherwood's exciting Crop Drop Scheme that aims to build stronger connections in our community and enable families to access healthy, affordable produce.

NSDC are coordinating the distribution of fruit and vegetables from local allotments and growers. Volunteer drivers from either the allotment or within the community will then transport the donated produce to charity projects, food clubs and educational settings.

We are proactively trying to work to link allotments and food projects within the area to help strengthen communities, alleviate food waste and increase consumption of healthier, more affordable fresh produce. And we would love you to be part of this scheme.



HOW IT WORKS

On an agreed day allotment holders leave their donations in an arranged collection box on-site, protected from the weather and potential hungry animals.

A volunteer driver will then deliver the fruit and vegetables to a community project, who will distribute to families and individuals accessing their group.
