

Community Infrastructure Levy

Balderton Parish Council receives a proportion (15%) of C.I.L. monies that are paid to Newark & Sherwood District Council (N&SDC) for any qualifying development within the village.

The Parish Council is restricted as to how this fund of money can be spent; either on the provision, improvement, operation or maintenance of infrastructure, or anything else that is concerned with addressing the demands that development places in our area. However, the Council can still only spend this fund of money within the remit of its statutory powers and duties as laid out in Local Government Law.
